Registration/ Grading

- Now grading has been completed, clubs will need to complete the additional registration form from here on in and email to Veronica by COB 17/03/2020, for players to be eligible to participate in Round 1 of the competition.
- Players must also be ACTIVE in play football by the 17/03/2020 to be eligible to participate in Round 1.
- The office will unallocated any players from teams that have not been made active or are missing photos on the 18/03/2020. These players will not be eligible to participate in Round 1 and will need to be resubmitted on the additional registration form the following Monday.
- After the 17/03/2020, Clubs are required to submit the additional registration form each Monday by 7pm.
- Can clubs please go into play football and rename your competitive teams according to final grading
