Please find below recent Board determinations made and current issues.

COVID-19

BDAFA COVID-19 Action plan:

As discussed at our meeting, please find attached the process to follow should a member test positive to COVID-19.

COVID-19 Risk Register – Return to Training

We have attached a Risk Register the office has created for return to training. Clubs are able to modify if you have other identified risks not noted.

We have submitted this to Council and confirm that canteens and clubrooms will be able to be used as per the public health order

The NSW State Government has not yet endorsed the Australian Sports Commission Sport tool kit. (attached letter in email) BDAFA will still be implementing a COVID-19 Safety Coordinator at field to ensure communication flows smoothly to all participants and parents.

We will continue to follow the FNSW guidelines and if the tool kit becomes a requirement the office will complete for Clubs as discussed at the Clubs meeting.

Could Clubs please notify the office of your COVID-19 Safety office.

For your reference, the below is required of Safety Officer:

The COVID-19 Safety Coordinator will be your key resource and central point of contact for all matters COVID-19 for your organisation.

The Safety Coordinator will be responsible for liaising with other clubs, associations, State and National Sporting Organisations and other relevant stakeholders in relation to your organisation's response to COVID-19.

COVID-19 Online Course:

If Clubs are interested there is a free online COVID-19 course. It takes about 10-20 minutes to complete and you receive a certificate when completed. I have attached my certificate for reference.

Posts:

Council have advised posts will be installed once a confirmed Start date has been announced by the NSW Government.

Council will be liaising with BDAFA regarding the roll out of post installation.

Registration:

As discussed in the meeting please find the following dates, we will be working on for registrations over the next month.

The draw has been updated with our target July return.

We are preparing for a 4th & 5th of July start, FNSW are also seeking an exemption for this start date.

The preparation dates for the start of the season have been revised to the following:

From the 1/6/2020

- Training can commence as per the public health order, currently a maximum of 10 people. This will allow clubs time to pick up Sanitiser and resources from the office and communicate to all coaches and members.
- Payment of registrations, process new registrations and process any deregistration's. Please check all participants have photos in Play football.

Sunday the 14th of June 2020

- 1st Round cut off for all registrations
- Any changes to clubs grading to be submitted. New teams and teams to be removed.

The 16th & 17th of June 2020 – Re-access competition structures if required and publish to clubs.
